

Hosted Games

This is the information pack for hosted games to be run at the Midgard Moot event at Boards And Swords Hobbies on April 26th 2025.

What's happening on the day?

During the day, you will play two games of Midgard in two different settings. All miniatures, dice, markers and terrain will be provided – all you need to do is turn up and play. We are very lucky to have some experienced games masters (including several members of the play test team) who will be putting on a show for you.

While the themed campaign players will be playing three 300-point games limited to two hours each, you'll have a more leisurely day playing two different games of around three hours each. Games will be using Forces around 400-500 points and will mostly be played with two players a side. While experienced players will be enjoy getting their teeth into the different scenarios, the hosted games are also a great opportunity to learn how to play.

Game	Details
1. Teutoburger Wald 9 AD	Mike Wilkins takes us deep into the forests of ancient Germania in this 28mm historical action: can the bold Romans fight their way out of the ambush?
2. The Old World	Lard veteran Jeremy Short ventures into the popular and much-neglected Warhammer fantasy world to pull out his amazing collection of classic 28mm miniatures.
3. The Lord of the Rings	Top game host and painting machine Matt Slade brings the Third Age of Middle-earth to the table with his outstanding 28mm miniatures collection.
4. Harfleur 1415 AD	Another historical entry as 'What a Cowboy' author and Lard cycling champion John Savage goes back in time to channel the spirit of Henry V to 'Cry God, for Harry! England and St George!'
5. Degsastan 603 AD	Play tester Andy Mactaggart revisits the mighty clash between Dalriada and Northumbria at 'Degsa's Stone' using James's 15mm miniatures collection.
